Policy:

Orde Day Care is committed in providing a health and safe environment for the children, staff/students/volunteers and families by following specific procedures and guidelines set by Toronto Public Health Department, in relation to three specific areas of focus. These policies and procedures are centre specific and reviewed annually by the management and staff, students and volunteers of Orde Daycare. Additions and deletions in accordance with changes in practices or best practice will be reflected in these policies.

1. Infection prevention and control to ensure our health and safety practices promote the well being of the children, staff/students/volunteers and families in the daycare using current or best practice guidelines
2. The response, management and reporting of communicable diseases and exclusion of ill children and staff/students to ensure current or future illness are contained or limited in their spread
3. Outbreak Management, to define a clear understanding of what is considered an outbreak, how it is communicated and procedures to follow to reduce the spread of the illness.
